#### **Show Information and Rules**

- 1. Open to in and out of state exhibitors up to 21 years of age.
- 2. All registration papers must be in the exhibitor's name and be shown by the exhibitor.
- 3. The entry fee is \$25 per entry if registered by May 13, 2022. Late entry and day of show entry fee are \$50 per animal. Fees are non-refundable. Shirts are available for preorder through May 2, 2022. Shirts must be paid for when ordered.
- 4. Space under the barn is available first-come, first-served. Electrical outlets are limited. Generators are required. There are 40 horse stalls available first come first serve, the remaining will need to tie to trailers. Only straw hay is allowed if tying to trailers.
- 5. Pike County Junior Cattlemen's Association is not responsible for property loss or injury.
- 6. Showmanship will be based on the grade students will be entering for the 2022-2023 school year.
  - O Divisions- PeeWee(up to 3rd grade), 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th, Collegiate

#### 7. Heifer Show

- Heifers must be born on or after January 1, 2020.
- Commercial Heifers will be shown by weight.
- o Registered heifers will be shown by breed. Registration papers are required for all registered heifers.
- Show Management reserves the right to move any breed into an AOB division(s) provided there are five (5) or less total head entered. Grouping of breeds not meeting the minimum will be at the full discretion of the Show Management.
- o Top 5 will be chosen in the Heifer Show.
- Heifers may be shown in both breeding and market divisions.
   Two entry fees must be paid if showing in both divisions.

#### 8. Market Show

- There will be 2 divisions for Market Animals.
  - Prospect Market Animal Show- animals weighing up to 1,000lbs
  - Market Animal Show- animals weighing over 1,000lbs
- Market Heifers will have a separate class within the Market show.
- Top 5 will be chosen in the Prospect Market Animal Show.
- The entry numbers for the Market Animal Show(over 1,000lbs) will determine the amount of top placings in that division. For
  example, if there are 20 entries in this division, there will only be an overall Grand and Reserve Champion. This is at the
  discretion of the show committee.

#### 9. Bull Show

- Bulls must be born on or after January 1, 2019.
- o Bulls must be owned by the exhibitor.
- o Bulls will be shown by birthday following the heifer breed classes.
- o Bulls are not allowed to be used in showmanship.
- If a bull is older than 12 months, a nose ring is required.
- An overall grand and reserve champion will be chosen for this division.

### 10. This is a blow and go, NO FIT show. No paints, glue, etc. Animals should be shown clean and dry.

- 11. Camper hookups available for \$15/night. There are 20 camper hookups available first come first serve. 30/50 AMP service. No sewage. No cattle in the camper area.
