Entry and check- in will occur at Gate 1 (Main Gate) on your map starting at 6:30 am.

Check in and the show will occur in the Stock Pavilion. All weights will be declared within the Showman app upon check-in.

There will be no penning available in the barn. You must show out of your trailer.

It is highly recommended that exhibitors practice proper biosecurity procedures prior to and after the show.

Health Papers will be collected at check in. Be sure to bring a copy.

- 1. Swine moving within Wisconsin to Rock County Fair Park must have the following: Certificate of veterinary inspection (CVI) with the complete physical origin and physical destination address and the following information:
 - a. Animal identification (USDA 840 button ear tag, county fair tag, or ear notch)
 - b. Statement (on CVI) that a veterinarian has inspected the entire herd of origin within the past 30 days before the show and that no apparent disease was present at the time of inspection. Statement must also include:
 - i. Farm of origin of has not had pseudorabies or swine dysentery in the past 12 months, has not had any clinical signs or diagnosis of TGE or PEDV in the past 60 days, feeds no garbage, uses no PRV vaccine, is not under quarantine for any disease condition and vesicular stomatitis has not been diagnosed within 10 miles of the farm of origin within the past 30 days.
 - ii. Testing for Porcine Reproductive and Respiratory Syndrome (PRRS) and Porcine Epidemic Diarrhea Virus (PEDv) is required as follows:
 - 1. If Negative tests of herd of origin within 90 days prior to movement, pigs can move to fairs or shows as noted above. Documentation of the negative test results must be made available upon request. Test results, test type, and date of testing need to be included on the CVI.
 - 2. If Positive tests for either PRRS or PEDv of herd of origin within 90 days prior to movement, the herd will be quarantined until a herd plan is established and approved. Swine may be able to move to the fair or show in accordance with the herd plan. Include the test results, test type, date of testing, and Herd Plan number on the CVI.

All awards will include a sponsor sheet with sponsor information. Please make sure to send a thank you card to your award sponsor. If you lose this information, please contact the WLBA office. The WLBA has lost sponsors due to a lack of a simple thank you note.
