

Division Rules

MARKET STEER DIVISION

LIMIT TO BE SOLD AT PREMIUM SALE IS NOT TO EXCEED 10

1. Only one market steer may be shown by each exhibitor.
2. Entries for market steer will be due on the SECOND Saturday in October unless changes are made due to conflicts.
3. Entry fees for this division will be \$35.00. W-9 Substitution must be completed online each year and turned into your advisor on or before the date listed above.
4. All entries will be weighed-in and validated with ear tag, provided by the Livestock Committee, between 8:00 am and 9:00 am on the SECOND Saturday in October at the designated weigh-in site unless changes are made due to conflicts.
5. All entries must be owned and in the possession of the exhibitor prior to the first weigh-in. The animal must be fed and cared for under the supervision of the respective advisor until and during the show.
6. All entries must be dehorned.
7. All breeds will be shown together.
8. Entries may be broken into weight classes, depending upon the number of entries in the show and at the discretion of the Livestock Committee or Judge.
9. All entries in this division will be sifted at the final weigh-in by a sift committee which, when possible, will include a licensed Veterinarian.
10. Steers must be slick shorn, except switch not more than 2 weeks before show.
11. All entries must be taught to lead and be shown with a halter.
12. Any steer that is unmanageable by the exhibitor in a manner that results in the animal getting away from the exhibitor more than two times will be tied to the rail for final judging. If deemed both unmanageable and unsafe, the steer will be disqualified from the show and will not be eligible for showmanship or auction.
13. There is no minimum or maximum weight limits.
14. Premium sale weight is limited to the first 1,100 lbs.
15. Resale weight will be the actual weight of the steer.

17. All animals must be accounted for and removed from the fairgrounds immediately following the conclusion of the auction.
