

Division Rules

MARKET GOAT

LIMIT TO BE SOLD AT PREMIUM SALE IS NOT TO EXCEED 15

1. Only one Market Goat may be exhibited by an exhibitor.
2. Entries for goats will be due on the THIRD Friday in December.
3. Entry fees for this division will be \$35.00. W-9 must be completed each year and turned into your advisor on or before the THIRD Friday in December.
4. All entries must be weighed-in and validated with ear tag provided by the Livestock Committee on the SECOND Saturday in January, between 8:00 am and 9:00 am at the designated weigh-in site.
5. All entries must be owned and in the possession of the exhibitor prior to the first weigh-in. The animal must be fed and cared for under the supervision of the respective advisor until and during the livestock show.
6. Purebred and crossbred goats may be entered and shown.
7. Wether goats may be entered and shown. They must be dehorned.
8. All breeds will be shown together.
9. Entries may be broken into weight classes, depending upon the number of entries in the show and at the discretion of the Livestock Committee or judge.
10. All entries in this division will be sifted at the final weigh-in by a sift committee, which, when possible, will include a licensed veterinarian.
11. All entries must be taught to lead and be shown with collar or halter.
12. Goats must be slick shorn, except the switch, not more than two (2) weeks prior to the show.
13. Weight for show is a minimum of 70 lbs. one time across official scales.
14. Terminal show.
