

Division Rules

HALTER HEIFER DIVISION

1. Only one heifer may be shown by each exhibitor.
2. Entries for heifers will be due on the SECOND Saturday in October unless changes are made due to conflicts.
3. Entry fees for this division will be \$35.00. W-9 form must be completed each year and turned into your advisor on or before the date listed above.
4. Heifers must be at least 8 months and no older than 23 months at the time of tag in.
5. All entries will be weighed-in and validated with ear tag, provided by the Livestock Committee, between 8:00 am and 9:00 am on the SECOND Saturday in October at the designated weigh-in site unless changes are made due to conflicts.
6. All entries must be owned and in the possession of the exhibitor prior to the first weigh-in. The animal must be fed and cared for under the supervision of the respective advisor until and during the show.
7. All entries must be dehorned.
8. All breeds will be shown together.
9. Entries may be broken into weight classes, depending upon the number of entries in the show and at the discretion of the Livestock Committee or Judge.
10. All entries in this division will be sifted at the final weigh-in by a sift committee which, when possible, will include a licensed Veterinarian.
11. Heifers must be slick shorn, except switch not more than 2 weeks before show.
12. All entries must be taught to lead and be shown with a halter.
13. Any heifer that is unmanageable by the exhibitor in a manner that results in the animal getting away from the exhibitor more than two times will be tied to the rail for final judging. If deemed both unmanageable and unsafe, the heifer will be disqualified from the show and will not be eligible for showmanship.
14. There is no minimum or maximum weight limits.
15. All animals must be accounted for and removed from the fairgrounds immediately following the conclusion of the auction.
